| 1 | Word Association Game Introduce a few key words e.g. hygiene, germs, cleanliness, exercise. Use Vocabulary cards to display. Give each group a set of vocabulary cards. Ask them to come up with synonyms, antonyms or frame few sentences with words. | Word association game provide a fun and interactive way for children to reinforce vocabulary, spelling and language skills while also promoting social interaction and confidence building. | | |
| 2 | Health And Hygiene Crossword Puzzle Crossword puzzles with health and hygiene related clues can be created. Students complete the puzzle in pairs. Discuss the answers to reinforce understanding. | This activity encourages critical thinking, reinforces knowledge, and develops problem solving skills. Make learning about health and hygiene fun and interactive and encourage teamwork as well | | |
| 3 | Creative Writing/Writing prompt Provide students with a writing prompt related to health and hygiene. Allow students to write their stories /description. Encourage them to use the vocabulary words introduced earlier. Invite few students to share their writings with the class. | Writing prompt enhances their writing skills and encourage students to express, inspire critical thing, encourage personal reflection and allow students to explore creative ways to communicate their ideas. | | |
| 4 | Creative Presentation Divide students in groups and let them come up with a poem/poster making related to the health and hygiene topic. They can use the vocabulary words and concepts discussed earlier. | This activity promotes engagement through fun, build their confidence, foster creativity, develop their communication skills and enhance their understanding. | | |
| 5 | Hygiene Quiz Prepare flashcards with simple questions related to health and Hygiene. divide the class into two teams and ask each team to answer questions. | This activity helps to evaluate knowledge retention, encourage active participation, build their confidence. | | |
