- Once the sketches were complete, students proceeded to color their drawings using poster colors. The focus was on applying bright, vivid colors in a manner consistent with Kalighat painting traditions.
- Students were encouraged to experiment with color combinations and layering techniques to achieve the desired effect.

### 4. Final Touches:

o Students added final details to their paintings, ensuring that the vibrant and characteristic elements of Kalighat style were well-represented.





A discussion on the use of color and form in enhancing the artistic expression was held, allowing students to reflect on their work and the techniques applied.
