**Celebration of LINGUA FIESTA- English Literary Festival**

**Greetings of the day!**

We are pleased to inform you that **the school** will be celebrating the '**LINGUA FIESTA- English Literary Festival**' from **27 July 2023** onwards. A panorama of enlightening activities will be conducted to provide a more holistic approach to learning the English language and thereby ensuring a higher level of proficiency.

Following activities will be conducted for the students-

<b>GRADE</b>	<b>DATE &amp; DAY</b>	<b>ACTIVITIES PLANNED</b>
<b>GRADE 6</b>	<b>28 July 2023 FRIDAY</b>	<b>Acrostic Poetry Composition</b> Participants will compose a poem in which the first letter of each new line spells out the word provided for the poetry, i.e., 'NATURE' or 'FRIEND'.
<b>GRADE 7</b>	<b>28 July 2023 FRIDAY</b>	<b>Quintain Poetry Composition</b> Participants will compose a poem that contains 5 lines. It can contain any length or meter. The composition can be done for any type of quintain, like, cinquain, limerick, pentastich or tanka.
<b>GRADE 8</b>	<b>28 July 2023 FRIDAY</b>	<b>Comic Strips Presentation</b> Participants will create a narrative story with the help of illustrations and dialogues. A4 size sheets, colorful papers, color pens and sketch pens are the things to be brought by the participants.
<b>GRADE 9</b>	<b>27 July 2023 THURSDAY</b>	<b>Story Composition</b> Story Composition will enhance the skill and talent related to the art of creative writing. Each participant has to write a story of a minimum 120-150 words. The topic will be provided on the spot.
<b>GRADE 10</b>	<b>27 JULY 2023 THURSDAY</b>	<b>Play the News</b> Participants will take up the role of a journalist. They will be divided into groups and each group will present the news of the day under the headings- national news, international news, sports news, business news and weather forecast.
<b>GRADE 11</b>	<b>31 JULY 2023 MONDAY</b>	<b>Duo Extempore</b>



		Participants will be given the topics 4 minutes prior to speaking. The team must prepare the speech jointly, with one who begins and the other one concluding the speech. Presentation Time: 4 minutes, 2 minutes per member.
<b>GRADE 12</b>	<b>31 JULY 2023 MONDAY</b>	<b>Hot Seat Competition</b> Participants will be divided into a team of 4 members. Topics will be given to each team and questions will be raised by the other participants or anyone from the audience. Topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Questions from Flamingo and Vistas</li><li>• Current Affairs</li><li>• LGBTQT</li></ul>
<b>GRAND FINALE</b>		The concluding event will take place in the school's Auditorium. All the selected participants of Grade 10, 11 & 12 will perform and a panel of judges will judge them. Points will be compiled and winners of each category will get a reward.
